## YUGOSLAVCHIEFRABBISAFE Escapes Gestapo in Belgrade, Finally Reaches Palestine

is Dr. Isaac Alkalay, chief rabbi in Yugoslavia since 1923 and a Senator in the Yugoslav Parliament. He managed to escape the Gestapo during the Nazi invasion and subsequently he walked across the

country into Bulgaria, thence flee-

ing to Turkey. Dr. Alkalay, who is 59, had hid in the cellar of his house in Belgrade while his daugh-

ter upstairs informed the Gestapo agents he had departed. Dr. Alkalay is now en route to South Africa, where he will join Yugoslav statesmen, During 1914-18

he was active in England and the United States on behalf of the Ser-

bian cause.
