HALTS BORDER SMUGGLING

Bulgaria Arrests Those Trying to Send Corn to Greece

SOFIA, Bulgaria, Jan. 1—Attempts to smuggle contraband corn from Bulgaria to Greece were revealed today by Bulgarian authorities at the border. The Turkish population there has been trying to ship corn and other grains to Greece, it was learned, because prices there are around twelve times as high as the result of the war.

The Greek consular authorities, according to smugglers arrested by the Bulgarian police, gave them all facilities, because the Greek population in the frontier regions was in a starving condition after heavy snowfalls made the roads impassable.
